Most recently, Elizabeth received the Massachusetts Cultural Council Award in Painting.

Recent exhibitions include *Q20* at the Davis Museum, and *What Comes Around*, a solo exhibition at Montserrat College. Elizabeth is an Assistant Professor in Painting and Printmaking at Massachusetts College of Art and Design.
